ELDT Passenger Endorsement

Theory Training

Effective February 7, 2022, drivers that are intending to get a Passenger Endorsement will need to successfully complete ELDT Theory training before they are permitted to take the relevant knowledge test

The training will cover the requirements under 49 CFR 380 Appendix C

Post-crash procedures, Other emergency procedures, Vehicle orientation, Pre-trip, passenger safety awareness, ADA, Seat belt safety, Fueling, Idling, Emergency exit and evacuations, Rail road-highway grade crossings, Distracted driving, security and crime.

After the driver has successfully completed the Passenger endorsement training, NHMTA will enter the driver's information into the Training Provider registry. The driver can then schedule their knowledge test.
